

SOLDIER'S COVENANT RENEWAL SUNDAY, JANUARY 5, 2025 Meeting Element Ideas

The Soldier's Covenant Renewal Sunday is an opportunity for renewed commitment for ALL attendees of The Salvation Army, including soldiers, adherents, and individuals who call The Army their home. Although the Covenant is written with the soldier in mind, it may challenge those who have not yet made the commitment to soldiership to consider exploring this possibility. The following are some ideas you may find helpful in observance of this special Sunday opportunity.

Please prepare the following items before the service:

- Use the items below in your service, as desired.
- Print enough copies of the **Soldier's Covenant Renewal** for each soldier in your congregation. (Attached Covenants are formatted to be printed and cut in half.)
- Make pens available for Covenant signing.

Opening Prayer:

What is a Covenant?

A Covenant is an all-embracing binding promise or serious solemn agreement between two parties, often under oath and seal.

On this first Sunday of a New Year, as we gather together in community, we want to take time to renew our personal Soldier's Covenant. This is a sacred time of self-examination, reflection, and dedication; wholly giving up ourselves once again, or perhaps for the first time, in covenant with God and The Salvation Army. "Anything that we do, either publicly as a community of Salvationists, or as individuals, must be consistent with the declarations we make" (*Called to Be a Soldier*, pg. 78).

[As a congregation, you may want to recite together the eleven Salvation Army Doctrines of faith before distributing the Soldier's Covenant Renewal to reflect on and sign.]

Prayer Prompts:

- Thank God for the privilege of being a part of His plan for the world
- Ask God to help you reach even more people for Jesus
- Ask God to give you courage to break out of your comfort zone so you can speak for Him
- Ask God to put someone in your path today so that you can share the Good News

Father, we want to care about the whole world the way You do. Let our hearts be moved by the millions who have yet to hear the Good News of Your love. Help me to live up to the Covenant I have signed today. I commit the rest of my life to serving your purposes in my generation—anywhere, anytime, anyway. Help me to spread this message to others so they can become what you made them to be. In Jesus' name, Amen. (*The Purpose Driven Life Journal*)
