Food in Slovenia is made from the produce which they can grow on their farms. Many people keep bees and chickens – so eggs and honey are common ingredients. They drink **mleko** (milk) and, in the cold winter months, enjoy hot **juha** (soup) and sweet **cmoki** (dumplings). They are also fond of **potica** – a traditional Slovenian bread, baked in a ring, and containing walnuts, and **torta** (cake) often sweetened with honey.
