# Nazarene Bible College- English Courses (Fall/Spring/Summer 2024-2025)

Taking a course with NBC requires an application with the university. You will receive a link to this process once the course is approved. Please note. This takes some time, so do not delay in getting your SACEP registration approved to not miss the deadline for the required Orientation.

First-time NBC students must take the Required Online learning Orientation prior to the start of your course. Orientation dates are as follows for 2024-2025:

## Courses for 2024-25:

### THE2013-Doctrine of Holiness

A study of the biblical doctrine of Christian Holiness from a uniquely Wesleyan-Holiness perspective. Attention will be given to the historical, theological, and experiential dimensions of God's sanctifying grace. Prerequisites: Met with CFOT Transfer Credit - English Composition II, Introduction to the Old Testament, and Introduction to the New Testament. Course offered Fall A (Aug. 5-Sept. 15), Winter A (Nov. 11-Dec. 22), Spring A (Feb. 24-April 6), Summer A (May 26-July 6)

#### **BIB2003-Biblical Interpretation**

An introductory study of the principles of biblical hermeneutics. Emphasis is given to the methods and tools applied to the exegetical study of the Bible. An exegetical paper is required in this course. Prerequisites: Met with CFOT Transfer Credit - Introduction to the Old Testament or Introduction to the New Testament Course offered Fall B (Sept. 23-Nov. 3), Winter B (Jan. 6-Feb. 16), Spring B (April 14-May 25)

### CEM 2113- Foundations of Christian Educational Ministries

A survey of the theological and theoretical foundations of Christian educational ministries aimed at assisting the student to formulate a personal philosophy of Christian Education. Prerequisite: Met with CFOT Transfer Credit -Introduction to Christian Educational Ministries Course offered Fall B (Sept. 23-Nov. 3), Spring A (Feb. 24-April 6)

### OTR2013-Global Evangelism

An overview of the biblical, theological, and historical foundations for personal, congregational, and mass evangelism strategies, both local and global. Attention will also be given to the role of the Church of the Nazarene in global missions as well as the development of new Great Commission strategies. Course offered Fall B (Sept. 23-Nov. 3), Winter B (Jan. 6-Feb. 16)

### PAS2013-The Practice of Christian Ministry

A course giving special attention to the personal and professional character of the minister and the practice of ministry. Prerequisite: Met with CFOT Transfer Credit - Introduction to Christian Service. Course offered Spring A (Feb. 24-April 6)

#### PAS3013-Worship

A course providing an overview of Christian worship including biblical and historical perspectives. The major emphasis is on the pastor's role of formulating and leading worship services. Prerequisite: Met with CFOT Transfer Credit - Introduction to Music Ministries. Course offered Winter B (Jan. 6-Feb. 16)

### PAS3043-Christian Preaching II

An in-depth study of the preaching ministry including sermon planning, preparation, effective communication, and the application of homiletical principles. Prerequisite: Christian Preaching I OR, successful completion of the TERRITORIAL PREACHING SEMINAR Course offered Fall A-B (Aug. 5-Nov. 3), Winter A-B (Nov. 11-Feb. 16)

#### PSY4083 Leadership

A course examining the nature, functions, and strategies of leadership through a survey of current leadership and management literature. The case-study method of learning involves students in real, contemporary situations. Specialized attention is given to the pastor as leader. Course offered Winter B (Jan. 6-Feb. 16)
